Abstract submission



For AlComp 2026, all abstracts must be submitted exclusively through the <u>conference's website</u>. This document provides a guideline on submitting an abstract to AlComp 2026.

1. Create an abstract for AlComp 2026

AlComp 2026 requires the authors to use the template provided. The template can be found here: https://composites-ai.org/papers/

Please note that the final abstract submitted must be in PDF format. The file name should follow this pattern: **LastNameOfCorrespondingAuthor AlComp2026.pdf**.

2. Navigate to AlComp 2026 website

The abstract must be submitted via the submission form on the <u>conference's website</u> (https://composites-ai.org/papers/).

3. Submit the abstract

On the submission page, fill out the requested fields. All the fields are mandatory.

Please make sure to enter all authors' names and affiliations. The presenting author must be specified by placing a # in front of their name. A maximum of 5 keywords is allowed.

Once submitted, the message below will appear on the screen: "Thank you for your submission. A confirmation will be sent shortly. We appreciate your patience while we verify the submission."
